

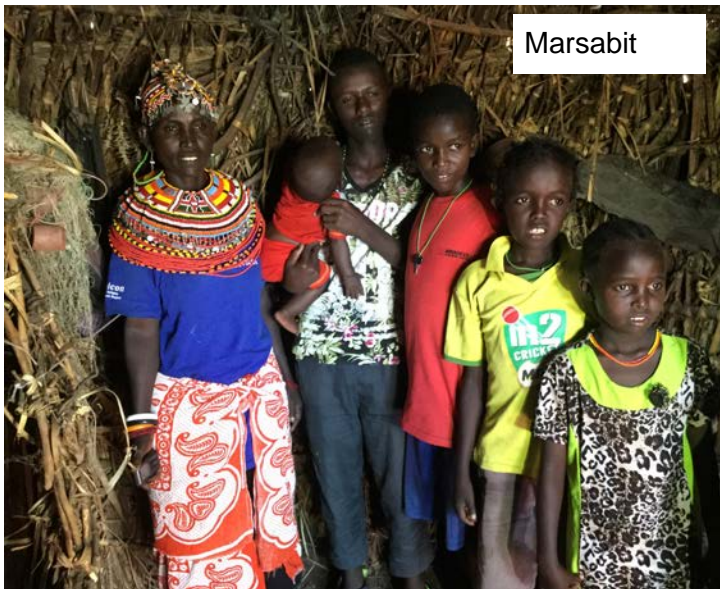
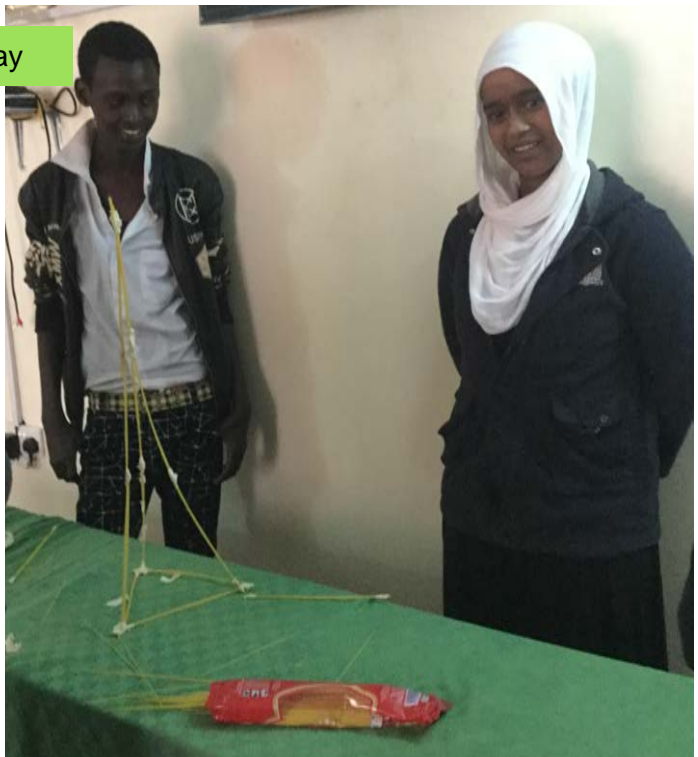
**BRINGING ON BOARD THE NEXT THINKERS. DOERS. LEADERS...**

With the academy finally closed, it was time to go to the next and final phase of the 2017 form one admissions. Vetting stage one had seen the receipt of over 8000 application forms from the 47 counties of Kenya. This stage required the sorting of all the applications forms both physical and those in soft copies into the various counties, male and female categories as well as the completeness of the application form with regards to all that was required during application. By the end of vetting stage two, which entailed the reading of the forms to assess financial need and skills such as critical thinking, entrepreneurship, responsible citizenship (community service), problem solving skills, academics and talent, this number was reduced to 450 students who were then invited to the county interviews.
